Dr. Adam R. Seipp is a professor of history and a fellow of the Texas A&M Arts and Humanities Program. He serves as Associate Dean for Graduate Studies in the College of Arts and Sciences. He holds a B.A. in history and African studies and an M.A. and Ph.D. in history. Dr. Seipp joined the Texas A&M faculty in 2005 as a member of the Department of History, where his research and teaching focus on modern German, European and military history. He is the author or editor of several books, including *Strangers in the Wild Place: Refugees, Americans, and a German Town, 1945-1952* and *The Berlin Airlift and the Making of the Cold War*, in addition to articles in multiple journals, including *Central European History*, *German Politics and Society*, *Holocaust and Genocide Studies* and the *Journal of Military History*. Dr. Seipp's research has been supported by the Fulbright Program, German Marshall Fund, German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD), United States Holocaust Memorial Museum and the US Army Military History Institute. Previously, he served as Associate Dean of the Graduate and Professional School as well as Associate Department Head and Director of Graduate Studies in the Department of History.
